D100: DELICIOUS DRINKS OVERVIEW

Table Use

This table is presented in a D100 rollable format. Looking for a quick random fantasy drink on the fly? Roll a percentile die or two D10s and combine their numbers to find your beverage quickly.

The table is split into 5 rarities - Common, Uncommon, Rare, Very Rare and Legendary, with each containing 20 meals. You can alternatively, choose a rarity first and roll a d20 to determine the drink.

Lastly, feel free to simply choose a drink that's relevant to your situation from the list. These meals serve as excellent roleplay and immersion tools when running a campaign.

TTRPGs and Worlds

You may notice the drinks on these tables can be vague on certain aspects, the creatures used to make the drinks or the cultures they are designed for. This is intentional by design. Not all worlds have dwarves or elves and not all worlds have cows or chickens so apply your own worlds take on these foods where necessary. The variety is broad yet specific enough that drinks should fall into the relevant cultures and societies with ease.

This table is also entirely system agnostic, meaning it can be used for any fantasy TTRPG with very minimal tweaking required. Drink effects may require the GM to implement their own dice checks or rulesets relevant to their game, should they choose to use them.

Drink Effects

Each beverage in the table is depicted with a side effect of some kind. Some are harmless or sensory, whereas others are powerful and affect the character or those around them in certain conditions. Your GM should determine whether these effects are relevant to the situation and whether or not they should be used, including if they require any dice checks or give relevant mechanical or numerical bonuses.

Remember these drink effects are OPTIONAL. Feel free to serve these beverages without the added bonuses or negatives.

Character Diets

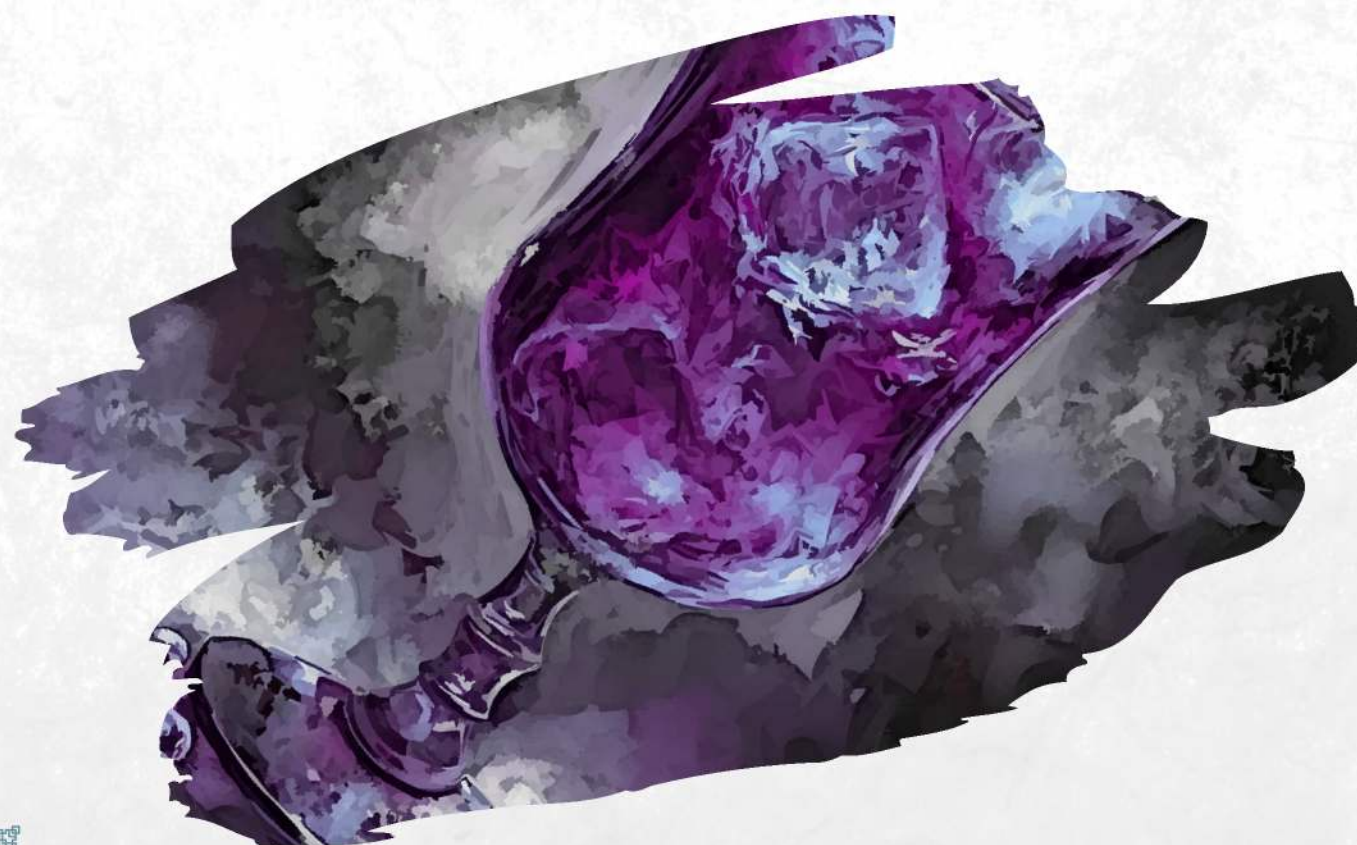
Some character's in your game may have special dietary requirements or preferences based on their lifestyle, choices or even religion. Whilst not always possible, most drinks have been designed to be just vague enough for GM tweaking as required. Feel free to cater to these needs and offer your players options, such as vegetarian, vegan or non-alcoholic alternatives.

Alcohol and Ingredients

Many of the drinks depicted have a core focus on being alcoholic, so feel free to add non-alcohol alternatives for these drinks. The GM also has room to add their own choices of mixers, garnishes, or any other additional ingredients if they feel the drink requires it. Common drink supplements include flavor enhancers or smaller additions, such as herbs, spices, or fruit slices. There are even drinks within these lists that could be served together as a signature cocktail and a complementary shot.

Drinks Culture and Prep

Drinks and their preparation may differ from culture to culture, so experiment with various styles of brewing and serving. One location might serve a cocktail shaken with ice, while another may prefer it stirred or muddled. Some cultures might even regard certain beverages as sacred, making their preparation more spiritual or ceremonial. In the same regard, many drinks may be exclusive to specific regions or cultures, enhancing immersion and giving identity to locations within your world. You might find that certain beverages in these lists fit some of your cultures better than others. If this is the case, try highlighting this feature to help that environment bloom and feel more believable. There might be only one place in your world that serves a particular drink, and perhaps that beverage is a favorite of a certain character, giving them a reason to visit or seek out that specific refreshment.

00	Clear River Water	A waterskin standard. Filtered water from the finest local rivers. The process of purification differs from place to place, with servings upon high mountains tasting best.	Simple sustenance and hydration.
01	Cattle Milk	A thick, creamy beverage that resembles liquid ivory, served in a sturdy tankard. It has a mild, slightly sweet aroma, reminiscent of pastures on a warm day. The flavor is smooth and wholesome, with a subtle hint of grass and earthiness, offering a comforting taste that feels like home.	Strengthens the bones.
02	Corn Juice	A golden-yellow drink that looks like freshly squeezed sunshine. Its aroma is sweet and earthy, evoking memories of late summer harvests. The flavor is rich and creamy, reminiscent of sweet corn on the cob, with a smooth texture that slides down the throat like a gentle breeze.	No effect.
03	Sea Apple Cider	Commonly referred to as 'Seader', this delicious cider is made from fermented sea apples, which are blue in colour. When ready, the liquid takes on a gorgeous teal colour, remniscent of a lagoon.	Creates a sea breeze sensation down the spine.
04	Mix and Matcha	A vibrant green liquid served in a ceramic bowl, infused with a blend of ground tea leaves and varied sweet fruit extracts. The aroma is fresh and earthy, reminiscent of a tranquil forest after rain. The flavor dances on the palate, combining the smooth, grassy notes of matcha with bursts of tropical sweetness.	Fills the drinker with ideas and creativity.
05	Pisswater	Created from the sterilised urine of local mammals. Travelers mix the liquid with aromatic extracts to offset the vile flavour. This undesired drink is common in extremely dry locations where preserving moisture essential.	Hydrates the body (Just).
06	Traveler's Treat	Delicious heat preserved hot chocolate. The hot chocolate is warmed by enchanted cocoa and retains is heat for days on end. Adventurers usually save its joy for when they need it most.	Warms the body in a comforting manner.
07	Dark Pulse Espresso	A small, concentrated shot of pitch-black liquid with a sharp scent that stings the nostrils. Its taste is intense and bitter, with a smoky aftertaste that lingers long after the last drop. It's known as a drink for those who need to be jolted into action.	Delivers an immediate burst of energy followed by a severe crash.
08	Glowing Grog	Created by deep delvers, standard rum is mixed with glowshrooms, an illuminating mushroom found deep underground. The drink coats the throat in the illuminating light, allowing those who drink it to light the way with a mouth.	Makes the inside of your mouth shine like a torch.
09	Juicebox	A badass colourful carton of fruit juice with three non-distinct stylish individuals on the front holding guitars. They appear to be some sort of band.	Boosts confidence and enhances charisma.

11	The Swamp Swig	A viscous, murky orange liquid with an earthy, almost rotten aroma. It’s said to be distilled from the most putrid corners of dark swamps, containing strange herbs and algae. Surprisingly, its taste is more tolerable than its appearance—earthy and salty, with a sharp, bitter finish that makes you feel like you’ve swallowed the bog itself.	Increases stealth in natural environments but leaves a lingering swampy scent.
12	The Meat Sweats	A thick, savory broth-like drink, warm and spicy, with chunks of meat floating in it. It’s often served in large wooden bowls and has a strong, peppery taste that causes an immediate heat to build in the drinker’s face and body.	Induces a heavy sweating and overheating sensation.
13	Slemon and Slime	A murky green drink with a gooey, slimy texture that sticks to the glass as it’s poured. The flavor is oddly pleasant—a mix of tart lemon and sweet fruit, contrasting with its off-putting texture. Some describe it as “drinking flavored jelly.”	The drinker becomes more slippery than usual.
14	Noble Pursuit	A rich, amber liquid served in an ornate glass, reminiscent of fine whiskey. The scent is warm and inviting, with notes of caramel, oak, and a hint of dried fruits. Its taste is complex and layered, starting with a smooth sweetness that transitions into a bold, spicy finish, reminiscent of a grand adventure.	You always know which way is north for the next 12 hours.
15	Commoner’s Jewels	A sparkling, clear liquid, deceptively luxurious in appearance. Its flavor is unexpectedly simple, a clean, crisp taste of fresh water with a slight sweetness. 17	Southern Hound	A strong, dark brown liquor with a smoky aroma, spiced with southern herbs and a sharp peppery finish. Its flavor is robust and earthy, favored by those with a taste for the wild. 21	Galvafruit With A Straw	A rock hard Galvafruit with a drilled hole for a straw to fit. Filled with sweet natural juices, the exterior is so sturdy that some cultures use them as a substitute for cannonballs.	Can be use as ammunition for a cannon or catapult.
22	Whoops All Bubbles!	A gassy drink which consists entirely of fruity bubbles and no liquid. The bubbles retain their structure as they go down the throat, only popping once they enter the stomach.	Leaves you feeling quite flatulent.
23	Faerie Firewater	This bright, iridescent liquid crackles with energy, shifting in color from vibrant pinks to neon greens and blues. It has a sharp, sweet taste, reminiscent of exotic fruits with a fiery afterburn that spreads warmth through the body.	Drinking this gives the imbiber a soft glow, making them visible in dim light.
24	Butterscotch and Buttergin	A mixture of tasty candy and a bizarre alcoholic blend. Invented by a wild top hatted man, who deemed the crossover of names to be a palpable reason to create such a ridiculous drink.	No effect, just delicious.
25	Blue-Cattle Energy	Mass produced and served in a convenient carriable can. This acidic and pungent energy drink will revitalise and enhance your overall performance, allowing you to stay awake easily.	Prevents tiredness and fatigue temporarily.
26	B Positive	A Roughly mixed blood drink of whatever low end creature is available. The blood type is not actually B+ but instead named as a joke towards those having to settle for suboptimal blood.	Decent nourishment for those requiring blood.
27	Cough-ee	Got a bad cough? This popular drink amongst the upper class is made with magical green coffee beans for a delicious blend with a simple purpose. When brewed correctly, the coffee resembles a thick green mucus.	Clears your cough and prevents further coughs.
28	Vicar's Vomit	A vile tasting strong ale mixed with holy water. Popular amongst faithful practitioners. It's believed that drinking this ale with both purify oneself and out evil doers, as their insides burn.	Inflicts great damage when poured over or consumed by undead.

33	Super Sour Star Fruit Surprise	A vibrant yellow drink with a tangy, citrus scent so strong it makes your eyes water. The taste is overwhelmingly sour, like biting into the sharpest of fruits, making even the bravest drinkers pucker up and tear up.	Causes your entire face to scrunch up slightly more than humanly possible.
34	Cigarette Break	Mezcal, grapefruit juice and agave nectar is sprinkled with activated charcoal powder. A visually appealing drink with a smokey flavour. It's topped with a flame lit rosemary sprig to sell its aesthetic.	Relieves stress.
35	The Black Cauldron	A heated bubbling brew filled with a multitude of different types of alcohol. The concoction is served in a large black cauldron, hence the name. Not suitable for those of low alcohol tolerance.	Intoxicates the drinker extremely quickly.
36	Northern Whisper	A pale, almost translucent drink that seems to shimmer with faint frost as it's poured. Its icy coldness carries the fresh scent of pine and snow-covered mountains, with a crisp, minty flavor that leaves a refreshing coolness on the breath.	The drinker may feel the presence and will of their ancestors.
37	Brawl Breaker	A deep, amber liquid served in a heavy mug that foams wildly when poured. It has a strong, bitter taste and is known to calm even the most rowdy crowds with just a sip, leaving a rich, malty aftertaste.	Quells aggression and knocks the drinker unconscious when aggravated.
38	Dancing Raven	Vodka, blackberry liqueur, lime juice, syrup and a garnish of blackberries. A shaken cocktail, popular amongst those with edgier personalities.	Helps one blend with the cover of darkness.

58	Vampire Killer	This cocktail is comprised of two cloves of fresh garlic, gin, lemon juice and a pinch of salt. Whilst its taste is nothing short of unusual, its still a desirable drink for those looking to hunt blood drinking evil doers.	Provides a temporary immunity to charms.
59	Spirit Sake	A translucent, silvery liquid served in a delicate porcelain cup, exuding a sweet, floral aroma reminiscent of cherry blossoms. Its flavor is smooth and subtle, with hints of rice and a faint fruitiness, making each sip feel like a gentle caress. When poured, it shimmers as if filled with tiny, dancing spirits. Its origins are unknown, and many taverns keep it as a joke to challenge foolish patrons.	Leaves the drinker with a bizarre sense of guilt, as though they've actually eating feces.

66	Teeth Whitener	Created with special toothpaste and vodka, this intense creamy alcoholic beverage flushes bacteria and burns your insides with a satisfying minty freshness.	Cleans up your teeth, making them sparkly white.
